

Esker Print Centre Passes Millionth Document Milestone

Derby, UK – March, 2012 Esker, global leaders in document process automation, are celebrating the success of their ‘on Demand’ services after processing the millionth document at their UK print centre.

Esker launched its ‘on Demand’ service for delivering business mail from its Northern European headquarters based in Derby just over 18 months ago in a bid to encourage businesses to ‘Quit Paper’ - and since then it has experienced unprecedented levels of growth.

When its ‘on Demand’ service was first launched in early 2010, only a few thousand documents were being processed at its print centre every month. Since then, there has been a dramatic increase in the number of local, national and international companies opting to use the Esker mail service in order to reduce the costs associated with the dependence on paper.

The company’s print centre now processes hundreds of thousands of documents per month and aims to hit the same 165% growth rates that have already been achieved so far.

Such has been the growth of ‘on Demand’ services for the delivery of business documents that Esker has expanded its mail facility with an extension to its premises and doubled the size of its facilities.

Commenting on the success of Esker’s ‘Mail on Demand’ service, Emmanuel Olivier, COO, at Esker said:

Plus, reporting and the ability to send one or one million documents on the same day it is received is always a compelling benefit,” added Emmanuel.
